Class Base Changes

Now that we are back into the swing of school, we have identified areas where we need to make some changes. Our EY Snowy Owls Class is quite a size after a number of new arrivals in school recently. We have therefore decided that they shall have the class base they occupy plus the class base our Year 1/2 Polar Bear Class has. Both Nursery and Reception pupils will be in these two class bases and can use the space this affords for their big numbers. This means that the Polar Bear Class will be moving to the room currently occupied by the Year 3/4 Arctic Wolves. The Polar Bear Class has 28 pupils so will be using the classroom at the front of school. The children in the Year 3/4 Arctic Wolves Class will move in to our IT suite which is not in use at the moment due to Covid-19 restrictions on room usage. This will become their class base. Staff hope to finalise these moves by the end of next week, 18th September. We will let you know about the new entrance/exit doors for these classes. We want to get this move done as soon as possible at the start of the school year so that the classes are settled before the end of the month. Our Narwhals and Arctic Wolves will not be affected by this move.
