<u>Test and Trace App</u> - The national NHS Test and Trace App is now available. The app is a key part of the country's fight against COVID-19. Cumbrians are being strongly encouraged to download the app to their smartphones now. The app is available on the Google Play Store and Apple App Store via <u>https://www.covid19.nhs.uk</u> The app will be used, alongside traditional contact tracing, to notify users if they come into contact with someone who later tests positive for coronavirus.
