Covid Update

We have had quite a surge in Covid positive pupils this week. A number of which were highlighted following the PCR tests. Pupils were showing no symptoms and hopefully our action has prevented further spread of infection. Thank you for all your co-operation. They will be invited to wear festive reindeer antlers and run a short distance at school. We have received the following message from Vicki Lesley, the fundraiser at Jigsaw: *Jigsaw is a place of fun and laughter where children and young adults can stay and create memories which will last a lifetime. We provide one to one care for children and young adults with life limiting illnesses, with the facility for up to five children and young adults for day support, with 2 able to stay for overnight and respite care. Our home from home environment allows the nurses to match the children and young adults home routines as closely as possible, ensuring a smooth, relaxing and peaceful transition between home and hospice environments.
