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## **Breakfast and After School Club**

The hourly fees for Breakfast and After School Club are to rise to £4 an hour. This increase will be from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June. We have kept the price at £3 for a number of years now and with the increase we will still offer an excellent service for your child/ren at BASC.

## Nursery Charges

The hourly charge for our Nursery will rise to £4 per hour from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June. Once again, we have kept the fees at £3 an hour for a very long time now and this is the first increase in many years.

## Ducklings

Our ducklings have grown immensely since they hatched and by the time you read this they will be on their way to their new home. Everyone at school has been very excited about these hatchlings and all the children in EY have learnt so much about lifecycles and caring for animals. Other children in school have also been very interested in seeing the ducklings and they have proven to be very popular with everyone. The ducklings are being rehomed with a family from school.

## <u>SATs</u>

SATs week is now over for our Year 6 pupils. They have done very well this week and handled the pressure excellently. They took tests in Grammar and Punctuation followed by a Spelling test. They then looked at a Reading Comprehension paper with the last two days involving three separate Maths papers. The children enjoyed their SATs breakfasts and their snacks. Pupils in Year 2 are also taking SATs and their tests are spread out over a much longer time-scale.

## Lockerbie Manor Residential

The pupils in Years 5 and 6 will be at Lockerbie Manor for their residential this weekend. Miss Stobbs, Miss James and Mr Ashton will be with the pupils for the weekend as they try out a wealth of outdoor activities. The children will be climbing, abseiling, paddle-boarding, rifle shooting and trying out the high-ropes course amongst other exciting undertakings. ## Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

You and your child/ren may be entitled to Free School meals(FSM) if your income is at a certain level. You can also check if you are entitled to Pupil Premium money that the school uses to enhance the education of all those who receive it. You need to apply for this even if you have other children already in receipt of it. In order to find out if you qualify, click on the link below:

## What do I do if another of my children starts school and I already have other children on free school meals?

If a child requires free school meals for the first time in September (for example - new starters in Reception), you will need to

submit a new application for that child only, regardless of whether older siblings are in receipt of free school meals.
