A one minute silence will be held across the UK at 8pm on the evening of Sunday 18th September. People can mark the silence privately in their own homes, on the street with neighbours or at community events or vigils.

This day has been announced as a Bank Holiday in the UK. Warwick Bridge School will be closed.
