Car Parking

Parents and carers are reminded that children should not be dropped off at school by parking on the yellow zig-zag lines. This can cause an obstruction and be dangerous for people trying to cross the road. The car park up at Downagate has ample parking for many cars and the walk to school is a short one. Please park with care and make sure you drop children off safely by not stopping on the yellow zig-zags. Cars must not be parked on the double yellow lines too.

Dropping off at School

Once the children have arrived at school on the front playground, we kindly ask parents and carers to stay with them until a member of staff comes out at 8.30am. The children will be taken to the back of school where they remain on the playground and field until 8.40am. During this time, there will be two members of staff to supervise the pupils. It is generally better if parents and carers then leave their children once they are in the back playground so that the entrance into school at 8.40am is as smooth as possible.
