Science	This term our science topics will be Evolution and Earth and Space.
Music	Our music lessons will be based on Melody and Harmony in Music.
Computing	This term we will continue to develop our understanding of coding as well as learning about computer systems and networks.
PE	Our P.E sessions for the Autumn term will be Action Ants on a Thursday, dance on a Tuesday and swimming on a Friday (Year 6).
RE	In RE we will be looking at Stories of Hinduism and How people express their faith through the arts.
Art	This term we will develop a range of art mediums linked to our topic of WW2.
Geography	Our geography will be linked to our WW2. We will also learn about European capital cities, Maps and atlases.
Design Technology	This term we will develop a range of D & T skills linked to our WW2 topic.
History	This term we will be looking at the history of the WW2 with a specific focus on evacuation.
PSHE	This term we will look at relationships and working as a team. We will also think about our health and well being.
Modern Foreign Languages	In French we will cover Presenting myself and the classroom.
