# Feet First Initiative

Our school will be taking part in the county wide Feet First 5-day Active Travel Challenge starting on **Monday 16 October** and finishing on **Friday 20 October 2023**. The challenge is for pupils and their families to choose an active way of getting to school as many times as possible over the 5-day period, supporting sustainable active journeys on the school run. During the challenge each child will receive their own bookmark on which pupils who have travelled actively can record their journey by adding a special sticker. Those pupils with at least one sticker on the bookmark at the end of the challenge will be awarded a small individual prize. We hope as many of you will walk, cycle or scooter to school.
