

Warwick Bridge Primary School Midday Supervisor Job Description and Person Specification

Salary: PCD3 £24,404 pro rata (FTE) term time only

Hours: 8.75 hours per week, 1.75 hours per day (11.30am – 1.15pm)

Post: Fixed Term Midday Supervisor

Responsible to: The Head Teacher and the Governing Board of the school.

Job Purpose

- Manage the day-today set up, clean up and running of the school dining hall to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the pupils in school.
- Supervise noise levels, behaviour and table manners of children.
- Supervise children whilst playing in the school playground.

Duties and Responsibilities

Planning and delivering activities

- Supervise pupil during activities and help resolve issues between pupils.
- Supervise activities and experiences for pupils.
- Offer educational instruction where necessary to support pupils to share.
- Monitor pupils throughout lunchtime and feedback any concerns to class teachers.

Health and safety

- Observe pupils and the environment and take action to minimise any identified health and safety risks.
- Deliver first aid and record details of incidents in line with the school's reporting procedures.
- Feedback concerns relating to pupils' health and safety to a senior member of staff.
- Co-ordinate regular maintenance of equipment and make sure the stock of equipment is maintained (e.g. first aid kits)
- Co-ordinate and offer support with setting up and putting away equipment safely.

Behaviour

- Report any incidents of serious misbehaviour to the relevant staff member, in line with the school's behaviour policy.
- Take necessary action to minimise disruption and harm to pupil, in line with the school's behaviour policy.
- Follow direction from class teachers on supporting specific pupils with challenging behaviour.
- Support pupils with their independence and self-esteem when carrying out activities.

Safeguarding

- Keep up to date with pupil information on medical/dietary needs
- Be responsible for pupils during the lunchtime sessions
- Report any safeguarding concerns to the Designated Safeguarding Lead and report on CPOMS.

Other areas of responsibility

- Read and follow the relevant school policies
- Undertake training required to develop in the role.
