Hello to you all from everyone at Warwick Bridge School. We hope that you are keeping safe and well at this time. We are still coming to terms with the present situation with the Covid-19 Response still firmly underway. Warwick Bridge school remains closed at the time being. This situation should continue for another three weeks or so. We will watch the announcements from the government and the Department of Education. Any decision to open schools cannot be taken locally – this is a national situation and any guidance the school takes will be from central government. We will keep you informed of any movement in this area.

Warwick Bridge School Childcare Hub

The school is open for the children of parents/carers who are Key Workers in the Covid-19 Response. A number of children from schools in the Brampton Cluster have attended throughout the past few weeks. The children have produced a rainbow banner in honour of the NHS frontline workers. This is on the railings that can be seen from the A69. They have also made a few bunting flags which are on the school railings.

Home Learning

All staff at Warwick Bridge School have organised learning for the pupils to do at home. The pupils will require access to the internet to do a lot of theses activities. If you have trouble accessing the internet please telephone the school. There is someone in school to take your call if you can telephone between 9-11am each day. You can also leave a message on the school answerphone and this is monitored daily. If you are having problems printing materials let your class teacher know. The vast majority of work, however, does not need printing out at all. Children can work from the screen and write the answers to work on a lined or plain piece of paper. If you are unable to print any work please contact your class teacher and we can arrange work to be collected from school. Don't forget that you can upload work onto Class Dojo for the teachers to see.

<u>Class Dojo</u> – Teachers will be using Class Dojo in order to set work and send you messages. If you are not on Class Dojo please email the class teacher with your details do they can organise work being sent. Staff can be contacted on their school email address.
